

Summer Arts Essons



Director's Note

Each musical we produce at HV Rep has new challenges and obstacles. Putting together a show from start to finish is sort of like working on a jigsaw puzzle without the finished picture to use as a guide. *Catch Me If You Can* was not well known to these students – the 2002 movie starring Leonardo DiCaprio and Tom Hanks was big before most of these kids were born!

When I first read the script, what struck me was vibrant colors from the Pop Art era. The set pieces and costumes and lighting have aspects of Andy Warhol, Roy Lichtenstein and others as inspiration. Another concept that emerged from these early readings was the idea of mobility. Not only in the title (makes me think of a chase) but also the fact that Frank Jr. can just up and move to new parts of the country in new jobs at the drop of a hat. In this show we visit New York, California, Georgia, Washington D.C., Virginia, and Louisiana! The set had to be mobile and the cast had to be flexible. We spent much time working on designs that were going to be able to be moved quickly by cast members - this was unusual for us - no set stage crew this year. One final aspect that emerged from early readings is the jazz influence on the music of the show. Jazz music is highly improvised and great actors are also able to improvise and adapt - Frank Jr. must be masterful at improvisation too in order to successfully infiltrate so many careers. We spent many early rehearsals working on improvisation techniques to help us find that agility in acting this show.

As with every year since I started at Hoosic Valley, I am truly impressed with the way the community comes together to produce such a wonderful spectacle each year. The number of hands involved has grown each year and I am grateful to each person for their efforts – nearly all of which are volunteered because of the love of theatre. Theatre brings people together because we have to be a team to put on a show – we learned that so much this year and we hope you enjoy the finished product.

Theatre Etiquette

Welcome to live theater at Hoosic Valley! Thank you for being here!



When the show begins, everyone in the audience has a responsibility. You are part of the play. You are connected with the other people in the audience and the ones on stage. They can SEE you, HEAR you and FEEL you, just the way you can see, hear and feel them. If you are talking about what you did yesterday or opening a candy wrapper, you will miss something. And it will miss you. Your laughter, your responses, your attention, your imagination, and most especially your energy are part of the experience.

So...to make it the best experience it can be for everyone please keep these rules of etiquette in mind:

- Please Do Not Talk during the performance. Please remember that talking to neighbors (even in whispers) carries easily to others in the audience and to the actors on stage.
- No food is allowed in the auditorium: soda, candy and other snacks are noisy and therefore distracting. Please throw them away before you enter the auditorium.
- Please do not get up or walk around during the performance. It is distracting to the actors and interferes with other people's ability to see the performance and enjoy the show.
- Cell phones, watch alarms and other electronic devices should be turned off before the performance begins.

Please NO TEXTING during the show.

Please be courteous and show respect to your theater neighbors by removing a crying or disruptive child. Nothing ruins a performance faster than trying to hear dialogue or music over the strains of a screaming child.

The auditorium doors will not be opened during the performance. If someone must leave as an emergency during the show, the doors will only be opened by the ushers, and not during a musical number.
